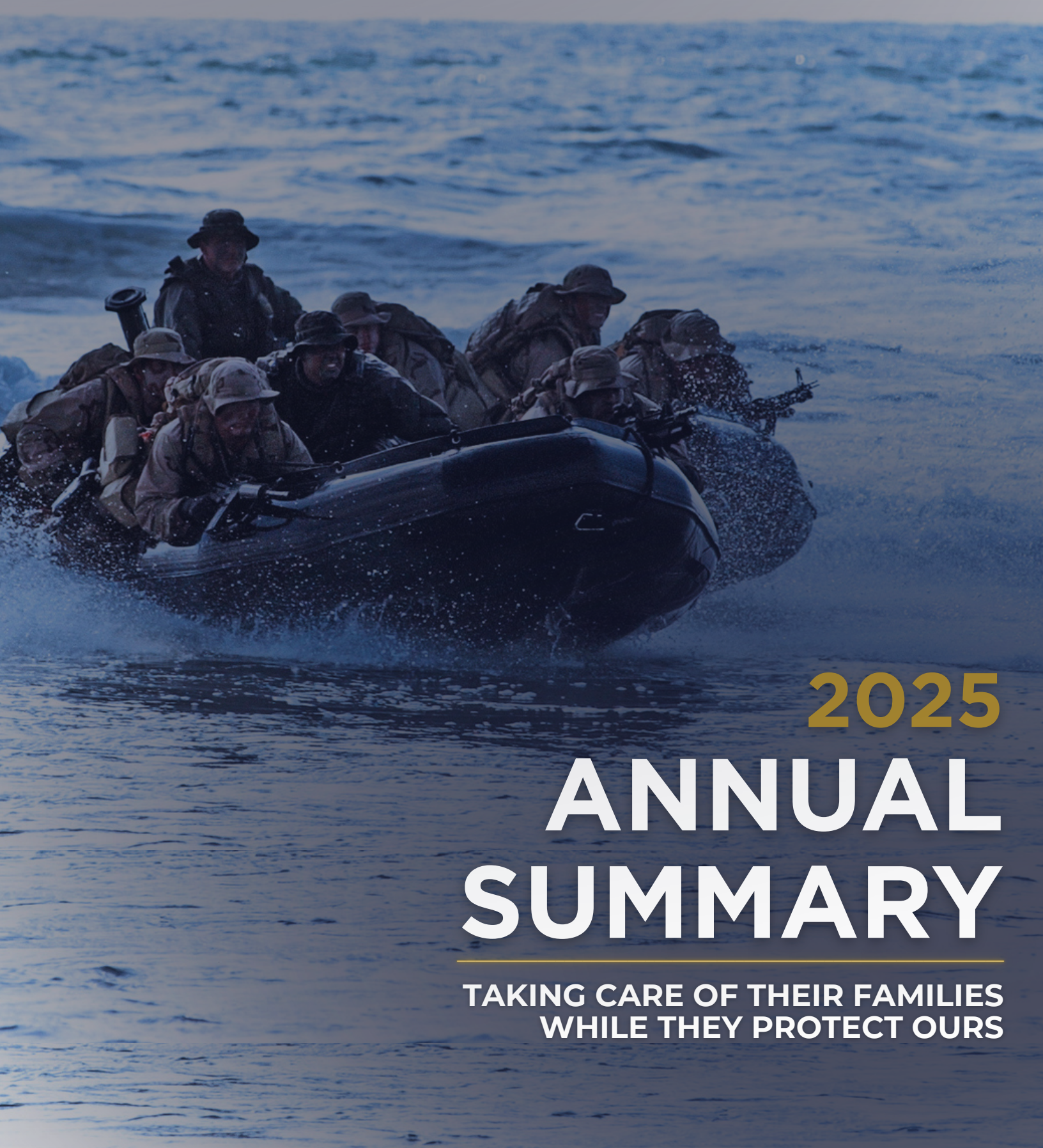

FROM OUR COMMUNITY

IMPACT IN ACTION

In **2025** SEAL Family Foundation supported Naval Special Warfare families at every stage of service — from active duty to reintegration and Gold Star remembrance.

Through direct assistance, community programming, and crisis response, we provided **\$1.57 million in direct aid** while strengthening connection, resilience, and readiness across the NSW community.

SEAL FAMILIES

When a Naval Special Warfare family faced a child's leukemia diagnosis and the demands of intensive treatment, your support helped provide stability during an incredibly difficult year—bringing a sense of normalcy when it was needed most.



Last year, we invested in the families who serve alongside our operators — reaching over **1,200 spouses** through **22 Sisterhood gatherings** and **15 Reintegration workshops**. We supported **65 NSW children** through tutoring, assessments, and advocacy in partnership with SEALKIDS.

Additionally, **34 Command Family Day grants** brought together over 7,000 family members across San Diego, Virginia Beach, Alaska, Germany, Mississippi, and Hawaii — strengthening resilience and community across the NSW community.

ACTIVE DUTY WARRIORS



From early training through milestone graduations, we remained present for active duty operators and their families. Through **47 graduation celebrations, Hell Week breakfasts, and training support events**, we connected with **over 3,500 family members**, reinforcing community during critical moments of service. When unforeseen challenges arose, critical injury and emergency assistance ensured timely, direct support.

GOLD STAR SUPPORT

We hosted **125 Gold Star family members** at Wreaths Across America in Arlington and San Diego, honoring their loved ones with dignity and remembrance. Through continued support and meaningful gatherings, we remain committed to standing beside our Gold Star families.
